Joe Sutphin is an illustrator of books for kids such as the Eisner Award-winning *Watership Down*, Helen Taylor's *Little Pilgrim's Progress*, Andrew Peterson's *Wingfeather Saga*, and the New York Times bestseller *Word of Mouse* by James Patterson. His love of nature, and of the living creatures in the fields and woods around his home, has informed his art for much of his life.




“Cheer up, Frog! You look grouchy!”


It starts as an update at one Chicago high school: copies of a certain book are no longer allowed in the classrooms or the library. But it's not just one high school—it's all Chicago public schools. Not even the principals know why this is happening; they just know they must comply with the order. One thing is clear: The book, which tells a story of oppression, survival, and resistance against authoritarian power, is seen as a threat, dangerous enough to ban.

One other thing is clear: Some of the students aren't going to let this go without resistance of their own. As the extent of the ban becomes known, the students rise up.
